Gaumer Process, 13616 Hempstead Road, Houston, TX 77040 (US Hwy 290 and West Tidwell, Northwest Houston)
From Downtown, Highway 290 NW:

- Take US HWY 290 North to West Tidwell (approximately 2 miles south of BW8 North/290 interchange)
- Take West Tidwell, West (left under 290 or right if coming from the BW8 direction) for approximately 3/4 mile to Fairbanks North Houston Road
- Turn left/South onto Fairbanks North Houston Road (southbound) and travel approximately 1500 feet to Hempstead Road
- Turn Left/South onto Hempstead Road and it is the second entrance on the left (just past Airgas welding)
- Park in front and come in the main entrance or look for the ASME signs

PLEASE NOTE: There is a lot of construction and traffic in this area so remain flexible and vigilant as traffic may change based on construction activities!!

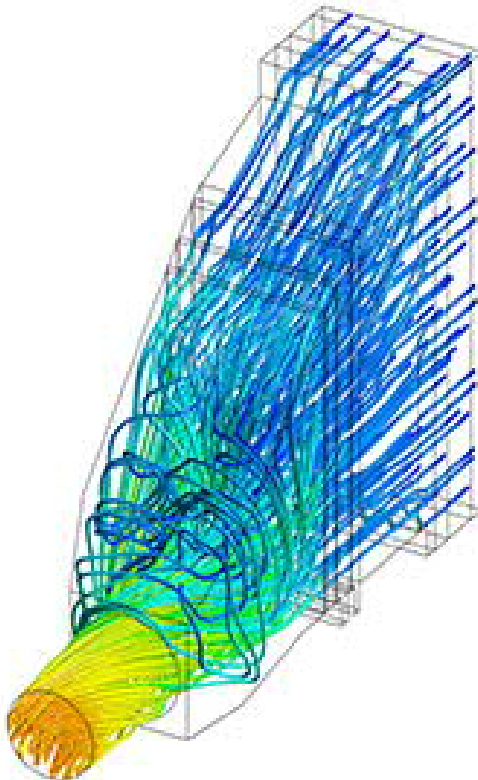
